I am pleased to invite you to submit nominations for the UNESCO/Guillermo Cano World Press Freedom Prize, created in honour of Guillermo Cano, the Colombian journalist who was assassinated in 1986 in the exercise of his profession, and supported by the Guillermo Cano Foundation, the Nicholas B. Ottaway Foundation and JP/Politiken Newspapers Ltd. (Denmark).

Awarded annually, the Prize consists of a medal and a monetary award.

As stipulated in the Regulations adopted by the Executive Board, the UNESCO World Press Freedom Prize is intended "to honour a person, organization or institution that has made a notable contribution to the defence and/or promotion of press freedom anywhere in the world, especially if this involved risk. Member States and international and regional professional and non-governmental organizations working in the field of journalism and freedom of expression may nominate candidates for the Prize".

Member States that wish to submit nominations must provide a written explanation of their choice, in English or French. Nominations should be submitted to the Director-General. No Member State may submit more than three candidates in the same year.
