CHILE

(Preliminary)

There are at the present time two sources of adoption in Chile.

In Santiago, Padre Piergiorgianni is an Italian Jesuit

Priest who oversees several orphanages - children available are mostly 2 years and older - one year old children regularly

placed and children under one year are sometimes available. Requirements are: children are usually placed with Catholic couples - however couples of other denominations are encouraged to write & inquire.

Both parents must be between thirty and fifty years of age. Couple must be married at least five years. Couples cannot be divorced. First preference is given to childless couples. Padre allows the child to be escorted to the United States by an employee of the orphanage - his airfare will be paid by the adoptive parents

CASA NACIONAL de SALUD - same requirements as above except at least one parent must

travel to Chile and stay for about 1 month
